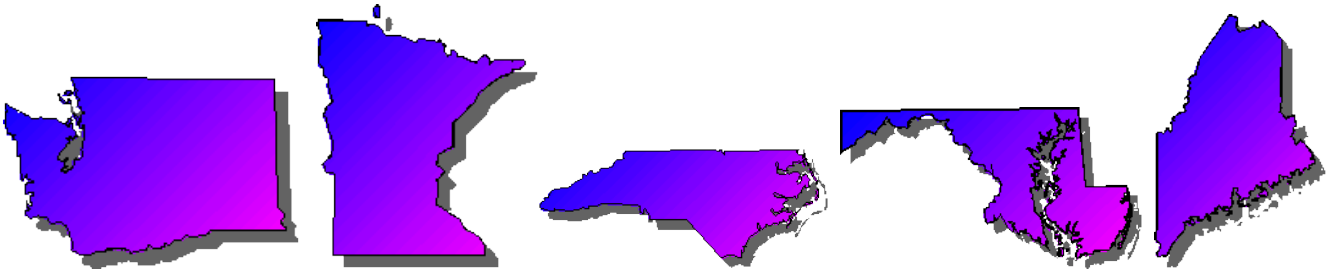


# A POST-ELECTION VIRTUAL GATHERING
